Time Length: 3-5 minutes

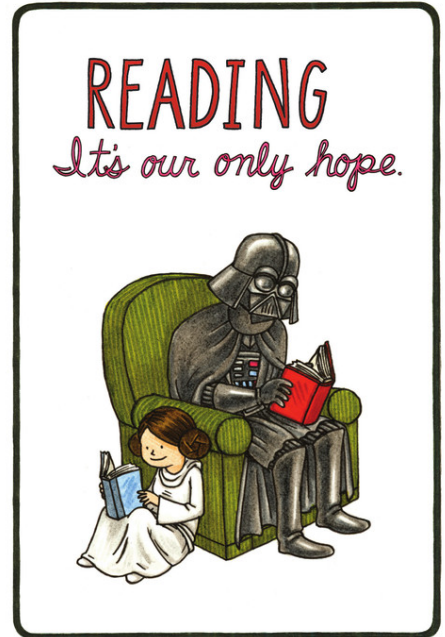
For term three, you will be asked to **set a goal** for the number of books you hope to read. These can be thicker fiction books, graphic novels, or thin quick reads. Talk to your parents about your goal.

Each Friday, Mr. Hodgins will be holding reading conferences where you will be asked to:

(1) give a quick summary of the book you read using the 'somebody wanted but so then' method, not a full retelling! *You will need to prep this ahead of time on the 'Reading Conferences' handout and come ready to the conference. See 'Wild Robot' example below.**

(2) You will also be asked to choose and read aloud a page that you either: thought was important, is filled with action, is funny, or stood out to you.

(3) When you finish your conference, you will put a sticker up on the books we've read chart and create an illustrated book spine of your novel to go on the book shelf.

Title of the Book – *The Wild Robot*

Author – Peter Brown

Number of Pages – 279 pages

<p>Somebody</p> <p>Who is the main character(s)?</p>	<p><i>Roz is a robot that gets stranded on an island. She has human-like qualities that she learns over time.</i></p>
<p>Wanted</p> <p>What did the character want?</p>	<p><i>Roz is very curious and wants to learn about the different creatures on the island and how to survive. She becomes friends with all of the different animals and becomes the mother of a small bird named Brightbill.</i></p>
<p>But</p> <p>What was the problem?</p>	<p><i>Enemy robots came to the island by airship in search of the 'missing' Roz to take her away, but Roz does not want to leave her family and her home.</i></p>
<p>So</p> <p>How was the characters problem solved?</p>	<p><i>Roz and the animals work together to destroy the robots that are trying to take Roz away. They kill all the robots, but Roz gets injured.</i></p>
<p>Then</p> <p>What was the resolution to the problem?</p>	<p><i>Roz chooses to leave the island in the airship to get fixed leaving behind all of her friends.</i></p>
