

# Vedder Elementary Expectations

## Review & Pledge

### Computer Room

- Students not to be in the computer lab without adult supervision
- No food or drink in the computer lab
- No outside software
- Student must have form signed in order to be on the internet (acceptable use policy)
- Log off computer & push in your chair when you leave
- Save your work in your own folder

### Teacher Work Areas/Photocopiers/Storage Areas

- No students allowed unless supervised by a teacher or parent

### Gym

- Students need to have indoor, non-marking soled shoes
- Runners or bare feet only in the gym, never sock feet!
- No students to enter gym unsupervised
- No food or drink in the gym unless authorized for a school event
- Equipment room should be left tidy and locked after each period or event

### Office

- Students need a signed phone pass to use the office phone
- Students waiting for parent pick-up are to use entrance couch
- Students should use classroom phone with teacher permission whenever possible

### Playground Support (Room B)

- Send students with work at 12:00
- Open 10:00 – 10:15 and 12:00 – 12:25

### Dress Code

- No spaghetti straps (shoulder straps two fingers wide are permitted), inappropriate logos or language, half size shirts or belly shirts, no see through material, no exposure of under garments, no extra short skirts or shorts, no low cut tops.
- Remove hats and bandanas before entering the building

### Bus

- Students line up and wait for the bus on the playground side of the fence
- Stay off adventure playground while waiting for the bus
- Must follow School Code of Conduct on the bus
- Students must stay on school property before & after riding the bus

### **Start and End of Day**

- Enter & exit through outside classroom door
- Go directly home after school
- Do not arrive before 8:00 a.m. when supervision begins

### **Miscellaneous**

- Leave gum at home
- Students are not permitted to ride on school property with roller blades, hee-lies, skateboards, bicycles, scooters or bikes.
  
- All electronic devices such as cellphones, ipods and ipads may be permitted for educational purposes with the permission of the classroom teacher. They will be used at the students own risk and should not be carried out onto the playground or without the teachers permission. Electronic games such as Gameboys and PS3's should not be brought to school.
  
- Students are not to use school microwaves to heat lunches.
