Gym

- > Students need to have indoor, non-marking soled shoes
- > Students will keep food and drink out of the gym unless authorized for a school event
- > Students will respect and take care of gym equipment
- > Students will respect the gym teacher and follow instructions

Office

- > Students waiting for parent pick-up are to remain seated outside the office
- > Students should use the classroom phone with teacher permission whenever possible
- > Students are asked to be quiet in and around the office, as it is our school work space

Bus

Before and After School

- > Enter & exit through outside classroom door or designated exit
- > Students will remain on school grounds during instructional time
- At the end of the day, students will go directly home. The playground will be supervised until 2:22 p.m.
- Students arrive between 7:50 and 8:06 a.m. There is no supervision prior to 7:50 a.m.

Attendance

- The policy at Vedder Elementary is to assist students in maintaining regular attendance in order to provide the maximum opportunity for learning.
- Research shows a strong correlation between poor attendance and lower academic achievement. Our stance on student attendance is simple: Attendance in class is expected, and it is the shared responsibly of the student, the parent, the staff and the administration.
